



## **A.P. Pharma Appoints Vice President Of Business Development**

Newly Created Position is Instrumental in Company's Business Strategy

REDWOOD CITY, Calif. (May 30, 2001) – A.P. Pharma, Inc. (Nasdaq NM: APPA), a specialty pharmaceutical company, today announced the appointment of Jayne M. Lange to the newly created position of Vice President, Business Development. Ms. Lange primarily will be responsible for developing corporate partnerships and collaborations for the Company's families of bioerodible delivery systems for injectable and implantable drug delivery. Known as Biochronomer™ systems, they are designed for the controlled release of drugs into various sites such as under the skin, in muscle or in the peritoneal cavity and offer potential for use in a broad array of pharmaceutical products. She will report to Mike O'Connell, president and chief executive officer. A.P. Pharma has a platform of bioerodible technologies in the drug delivery arena, which it plans to partner in exchange for traditional license fees, royalties and milestone payments. A seasoned pharmaceutical industry executive, Ms. Lange has more than 13 years of experience in business development with a number of leading firms including Novartis, COR Therapeutics and SmithKline Beecham, both in the U.S. and overseas. Most recently, she served as Vice President, Marketing and Business Development for Discovery Partners International, Inc., ChemRx Advanced Technologies Division, a medicinal chemistry firm spun out from Axys Pharmaceuticals. Prior to that, she was Executive Director, Business Development for Novartis Pharmaceuticals, a world leader in healthcare with operations in 142 countries.

"As we near completion of our pre-clinical studies, a critical part of our strategy involves partnering with pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies in order to bring innovative new products to market," commented Mr. O'Connell. "During her career, Jayne has amassed considerable expertise in corporate development, and has successfully negotiated numerous product licensing agreements and research collaborations. We are confident that she will be instrumental in commercializing our bioerodible drug delivery technologies, and also in advancing our proprietary product development programs."
